

January and Spring 2025 Registration Checklist

There is no application required to enroll in your first class at Harvard Extension School.
Instead, follow these key steps.

1. Create your MyDCE Account

MyDCE will be the hub for your student account.

2. Complete pre-registration

On the MyDCE dashboard, follow the pre-registration link to confirm your personal information and check if you need to meet certain enrollment requirements.

3. Choose your course

Log into Course Search and Registration

Pursuing a degree or certificate?

• Select your program under "Browse by Degree, Certificate, or Premedical Program" to find spring courses that fulfill requirements.

If you're not pursuing a degree or certificate:

 You can search by keyword or open "Additional Filters" to search by subject or participation option.

4. Add a course to your cart

- · Select a course.
- Click "Add to Cart" then click "OK."
- Select your desired credit status, and click "Save Changes."

5. Register for your course - starting November 4, 2024

- · Click on the cart icon at the top right corner.
- Click "Submit Schedule"
- The click "Submit Registration" to confirm.
- The registration results panel will appear confirming your registration.

6. Claim your HarvardKey

- You're a Harvard student! You will receive an email about claiming your HarvardKey within 48 hours
- You will need your Harvard University ID, which can be found in your MyDCE dashboard.

7. Pay for your course

- Log into MyDCE and select "Financial Services" to see your payment options and deadlines.
 Full Payment is due:
 - By December 5, 2024 for January courses
 - By January 9, 2025 for spring courses

What if I enroll after the payment deadline? You need to pay in full immediately.

8. Visit Your Course Website

Use your HarvardKey to log into your course website on <u>Canvas</u>.

9. Classes Start!

- January classes begin Monday, January 6, 2025
- Spring classes begin Monday, January 27, 2025

Enrollment Requirements

Test of Critical Reading and Writing Skills

Math Placement Test

Several math and economics courses recommend you take this test if you have not taken a math course recently. Learn more about the test.

Immunization Requirements

To take a class on the Harvard campus, you need to submit immunization documentation.

For international students

If English is not your native language, you must provide proof of English proficiency by:

- a. December 12 for January Session
- b. January 16, for Spring Term
