St. Peter School Teacher's Aide Internship Form

Each fall you can apply for a paid internship (\$15 per hour for 100 hours) at St. Peter School in Cambridge (K-8), www.saint-peter-school.org, where you can gain classroom experience as a teacher's aide to support a future career in education. You must be 18 years of age or older, have completed a minimum of 32 credits at Harvard with a 3.0 GPA or higher, and be eligible to work in the United States. To apply, submit this form and a résumé to alb@extension.harvard.edu. The deadline to apply is September 1 for fall term and December 1 for spring term. Successful applicants are required to undergo a CORI background check before starting the internship.

St. Peter's is open 8 am–3 pm, Monday through Friday. Interns typically work 10–15 hours a week over 2–3 days in the classroom. Interns work alongside the teacher, help an individual child (or small groups of children), and complete lesson plans in a variety of subjects including: literature, social studies, science, mathematics, religion, art, computer science, and music.
