What is the Greater Boston High School (GBHS) Student Scholarship?

The GBHS Student Scholarship is an academic scholarship offered by Harvard Extension School that gives select high school students the opportunity to enroll in (1) course (for undergraduate credit or noncredit) at the Extension School (*no Management courses permitted) at a reduced tuition cost:

* <u>Undergraduate Credit</u>: If you want to receive academic credit and grades, you must register for undergraduate credit. Check the course description to see available credit options.

** <u>Noncredit</u>: As a noncredit student, <u>you do not receive final grades or academic credit</u>, but the course you take does appear on your transcript. Not every course offers this option. Check the course description to see available credit options.

Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?

Students must meet **all** the eligibility requirements below to apply for the Fall 2025 scholarship. You will be **ineligible** to receive the scholarship if you do not meet all of these eligibility requirements.

Please note: Meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee a scholarship award. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, and funding is limited. To increase your chances of receiving a scholarship, submit all required materials as early as possible.

- At least 15 years old at the time of course registration (*registration opens on Monday, July 21)
- Currently enrolled in a Boston-area high school for the 2025-26 academic year
- Must be a high school sophomore, junior, or senior at the start of the 2025-26 academic year (graduation years = 2026, 2027, and 2028)
- 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA in all coursework attempted at your high school

What steps do I need to complete to be considered for the scholarship?

- 1. <u>Submit your online application</u> by Thursday, August 14 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern time. New students will be prompted to create login credentials. Returning students should use their existing credentials.
- 2. <u>Review the course catalog</u> to determine your courses of interest.
- 3. Submit proof of English proficiency if English isn't your native language.
- 4. Complete the mandatory pre-registration process on the home page of your MyDCE account.
- 5. <u>Add courses to your cart & submit your registration</u>. You can start adding courses to your cart on July 8 and submit your registration starting at 9 a.m. ET on Monday, July 21.
- 6. Submit 50% payment for your course (through your MyDCE account) by Thursday, August 14 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern time. *Please ignore any payment reminders that you receive from Student Financial Services after August 15.* A scholarship code will be added to your account by August 18 to cover the remaining balance owed for your course.

All students who receive the scholarship will be notified about this via email on Monday, August 18. Students not awarded the scholarship will receive a 100% refund for their 50% course balance paid.
